

CAT-EYE WINTERY TREE

- 1: Use Magic MLaq Gel Polish #39 Pacific Sky over the entire nail, to create your background color. Cure 30 seconds.
2. Create “textured snow” look from the free edge up by applying #2 Lily of the Valley extremely sparse, flash cure 10 seconds.
3. Add ombre’effect from the top down using a light touch with #7 Flawless Oval Brush and #335 Lilac Puff. Cure 30 seconds.
4. Apply Tackless Lux Matte Top Coat to nail, cure 1 minute.
5. Beginning with the bottom section of the tree, using MLaq #371 Green Cat Eye and the #6 Swirls & Shades Brush, create the lower 1/3rd section of the tree, DO NOT CURE!
 - Use magnet to activate the magnetic particles, and position your “flash” so it is near the center and there is a slight darker line along the bottom edge of the branches.
 - Next, use the #4 Essetial Detailer Brush and pull small lines of color away from the edges of the tree, to create fluffy branches. Next, drag it through various areas of this section of the tree, to create texture and depth, adding the look of branches. Flash cure 10 seconds.

5. Move on to repeat Step 4, creating the middle section of the tree, repeating all steps and flash curing for 10 seconds.
6. Move on to repeat Step 4 again, creating the top portion of the tree, repeating all steps and flash curing for 10 seconds.
7. Using MLaq #291 MLaq Crystals and #3 Tiniest Detail Brush, pull a single glitter chunk and in place as the tree topper. Flash cure in place.
8. Apply Tackless Hyper Shine Top Coat only over the tree, Cure 1 minute.
9. Using #198 Snowball Styler Gel and the #4 Essential Detailer Brush, add 3D snow accents on the tree and on the ground beneath the tree, Do not Cure.
10. Using a clean #4 brush, tap the "snow" that was added, to create a little texture and more of a "wind-blown" look. Once happy, cure 1 minute and cleanse to remove any possible inhibition layer remnants.
